THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

- In case there are less than 60 riders after receiving final entries, a Rider/Horse couple has to finish the first round of one of the qualifying competitions mentioned above. (Comp. No's : 4, 7, 8, 11)
- Rider/horse couple is automatically qualified if the conditions mentioned in Annex IV of the FEI Jumping Rules is met :

"Annex IV: Qualification for the Grand Prix competition at CSIO Events (Art. 261.4)

The following are automatically qualified for the Grand Prix at CSIOs, if present as official team members or individual:

- The individual medal winners of the last Olympic and Pan American Games, of the last World and Continental Championships and the first three placed athletes/horses combination in the last FEI World Cup™ Final.
- Eligible to participate in Grand Prix competitions at 5* CSIO events are the winners (athletes/horses combination) of the Grand Prix at any 5* CSIO event during the previous 12 months.
- Eligible to participate in Grand Prix competitions at 4* CSIO events are the winners (athletes/horses combination) of the Grand Prix at any 4* or 5* Nations Cup CSIO event during the previous 12 months."

JR Article 254.4 & 5

"4. At CSIOs each Athlete may ride only one horse in the Grand Prix or, if there is no Grand Prix, in the competition with the highest prize money. If there is a Grand Prix competition and another competition with the same prize money as the Grand Prix or with higher prize money, the Athlete may ride only one horse in each of these competitions, except when this competition is a Derby.

5. This also applies at CSIs. However, if in the Grand Prix or in similar competitions listed in paragraph 4 above, there are 30 Athletes or less entered, the Organising Committee may allow each Athlete to ride two horses in the competition concerned, provided that the total number of starters does not exceed the maximum allowed for the Grand Prix or competition in question."
